In the second half of 19th century Mr. Mahagaonkar, a dedicated teacher started his private coaching classes for the natives in Pune. A trio, Bhajekar, Bhave and Indapurkar took mantle from him. This endeavor got a shape of educational institution with the joining of late revolutionary freedom fighter, Adya Krantikar Vasudeo Balwant Phadke. In-1874 the 'Poona Native Institution' took shape as their joint effort. The institution imparted conventional, contemporary education. The mission of grooming the youth to take challenge against the British rule spread across Pune city and district in the early years of 20th Century. In 1922, the institution was renamed as Maharashtra Education Society which today is proudly known as MES, not only in Maharashtra but also in different parts of India for Quality Education from KG to PG levels.

The MES resembles a 'Dnyan Vriksha' completing 150 years, comprising of 40 institutions, with strength of 40,000+ students, teachers and administrative staff.
